

**NORTH CLAY COMMUNITY UNIT #25 BOARD OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING, NOVEMBER 8, 2010**

A motion was made by Britton, seconded by Worthey, to enter into closed session for the purpose of:

a. Student disciplinary case (5 ILCS 120/2©(9))

Ayes: Britton, Cochran, Rinehart, McKnelly, Smith, Worthey, and Bailey. Nays: None. The motion carried.

The board was in closed session from 5:15 P.M. – 6:20 P.M.


A motion was made by Worthey, seconded by Rinehart, to enter open session: Ayes: Cochran, Rinehart, McKnelly, Smith, Worthey, Britton, and Bailey. Nays: None. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Cochran, seconded by Smith, that student 11/08/10A be found to have violated school rules and that he be expelled from North Clay Unit 25 School District for beginning 11/08/10 and ending at the end of the first semester of the 2011-12 school year. Further moved that the expulsion be stayed and that he be placed on school probation for that period. In accordance with the agreement to be signed by the student, his parents, and the administration, violation of school probation will result in imposition of the expulsion.”
